Preface

Collection and dissemination of statistics on livestock slaughter in the national slaughterhouses is one of the routine activities of the Statistical Centre of Iran which has begun since the year 1347 (1968). The statistical information, which is provided in this way to planners, executive authorities and researchers, whenever combined with other available information on the geographical distribution of national population, imports and exports, and informal livestock slaughter, can be used in view of following points:

1. Calculation of per capita supply of red meat as one of the indexes of the socio-economic status.
2. Estimation of some of the statistical items related to livestock slaughter, such as hide, intestine, head, trotters and entrails of the livestock.
3. Average changes in carcass weight as an index for recognizing the status of the nation's pastures
4. Planning for probable meat imports and its appropriate distribution in the country.

One of the important characteristics of the livestock slaughter statistics in the national slaughterhouses is the continuity and speed of its collection and extraction process, of which the information obtained could be used for planning very quickly and at short intervals.

We would like to express our appreciation to the veterinary networks, national slaughterhouses and the Provincial Plan and Budget Organization for their sincere cooperation in implementing this survey. All researchers and well-informed people are expected to provide us with their own comments in order to improve this publication.

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Introduction

The first statistical publication on livestock slaughter in Iran was published by the Ministry of Economy in the month of Khordad (22 May-21 June) of the year 1344 containing statistics on livestock slaughter for the years 1338 to 1343 in the cities with a population of over 5,000 people based on the Population and Housing Census conducted in the year 1335. Since then until the year 1346, livestock slaughter statistics would be prepared by the General Department of the mentioned Ministry. Since the year 1347, the livestock slaughter survey implementation has been ceded to the Statistical Centre of Iran. Until the year 1375, the mentioned statistics were collected through correspondence or direct visit to the municipalities throughout the country by this Centre. However, since the year 1376 and due to the expression of the readiness by the Veterinary Organization for cooperation in this field, all slaughterhouses covered by the veterinary networks were enumerated. To implement this survey, a questionnaire along with its completion instruction is provided to the officials of the slaughterhouses via the Provincial Plan and Budget Organization. The officials of the slaughterhouses complete the monthly questionnaire by using the statistics that are regularly registered and return it to the provincial Plan and Budget Organization. After making the necessary checks and reviews, the Organization will perform data entry based on the completed questionnaires and send the registered data. at the end of each season, to the Statistical Centre of Iran for final check and review, extraction and dissemination of the data. The number of slaughterhouses covered by the survey in the year 1395 is presented in Table 13 by province. In using the statistics of the current publication, following points should be taken into accounts:

- (A) The statistics do not include the information on livestock slaughter in the rural areas out of the veterinary network coverage.
- (B) The presented statistics exclude the information on unauthorized livestock slaughter in cities.
- (C) Authorized slaughterhouses in private sector are included in this survey.
- (D) The statistics on the livestock slaughter in private slaughterhouses in each province is presented under the title of "Other slaughterhouses" in the last line of table" related to each province.
- (E) The unit for camel in the related tables is "head".

General Characteristics of the Survey

Background

The survey of livestock slaughter statistics in the national slaughterhouses is one of the routine activities of the Statistical Centre of Iran, which has been implemented since the year 1347 so far and related results have been published.

The Necessity of the Survey Implementation

The statistical information which is provided in this way to planners, executive authorities and researchers throughout the country can be used from the following viewpoints whenever combined with other available information on geographical distribution, population, imports and exports of livestock and meat products:

- Calculation of per capita supply of red meat as one of the indexes of the socio-economic status.
- Estimation of some of the statistical items related to livestock slaughter, such as hide, intestine, head, trotters and entrails of the livestock or the number of livestock available in the country.
- Use of carcass average weight changes as an index to recognize the status of national pastures.
- Planning for importing red meat and its appropriate distribution in the country.
- Meeting of statistical requirements of economic accounts.
- Meeting of statistical requirements of other organizations.

Objectives of the survey

A) General objectives: the overall objective of this survey is to collect and provide information needed for planning, policy-making, research, supervision and management of executive operations in the field of livestock slaughter in the national authorized slaughterhouses.

B) Detailed objectives: total number of livestock slaughter, total carcass weight and average weight of one head of slaughtered sheep and lambs, goat and kids, cattle and calves, buffalo and calves and camel and calves, number, weight and average weight of the confiscated carcasses of sheep and lambs, goat and kids, cattle and calves, buffalo and calves and camel and calves.

Type of the survey

The method of this survey is complete enumeration.

Statistical frame

The list of slaughterhouses, whether public and private, which are officially authorized by the National Veterinary Organization in the year 1395, is the statistical frame of this survey.

Statistical population

All national authorized slaughterhouses in the year 1395 form the statistical population of this survey.

Statistical unit

The statistical unit of the survey is a national authorized slaughterhouse.

Survey date

The time for taking this survey is the end of each month.

Statistical date

The statistical time for implementing this survey is every month of the year.

Level of information dissemination

The statistics and information collected will be presented at the national and provincial levels.

Summary Statistics on Livestock Slaughter in the National Slaughterhouses – the year 1395

The survey of livestock slaughter statistics collection in the national slaughterhouses is one of the routine activities of the Statistical Centre of Iran, which has begun since the year 1347 (1968).

According to the results of this survey in the year 1395, there were 374 livestock slaughterhouses in the country out of which 340 slaughterhouses were affiliated to the public and 34 ones for private sectors. The highest number of slaughterhouses is for Fars province with 35 slaughterhouses including 32 public and 3 private ones, and the lowest number of slaughterhouses goes to Alborz and Qom provinces with 2 slaughterhouses.

A summary of the livestock slaughter statistics in the year 1395 is as follows:

- The amount of red meat production in the national slaughterhouses was 448 thousand tons by the weight of slaughtered carcasses.
- The number of edible carcasses of slaughtered sheep and lambs was 9709 thousand with the weight of 176 thousand tons, which the province of Tehran with the number of 1880 thousand carcasses with the weight of 29 thousand tons had the highest number of carcasses.
- The number of edible carcasses of goat and kids was 2388 thousand with the weight of 35 thousand tons. Esfahan province with 578 thousand carcasses with the weight of 7.6 thousand tons had the highest number.
- The number of edible carcasses of cattle and calves was 1183 thousand with the weight of 228 thousand tons and the highest number was for Tehran province with 203 thousand carcasses with the weight of 34 thousand tons.
- The number of edible carcasses of slaughtered buffalo and calves was 24 thousand weighing 4.5 thousand tons. The province of Khuzestan had the highest number with 9 thousand carcasses with the weight of 1.8 thousand tons.
- The number of edible carcasses of camel and calves was 24 thousand with the weight of 5 thousand tons. Kerman province had the highest number with approximately 4650 carcasses weighing 0.7 thousand tons.
- The average weight of a sheep and lamb carcass was 18.09 kgs, goat and kid was 14.52 kgs, cattle and calf was 192.5 kgs, buffalo and calf was 186.78 kgs and camel and calf was 213.37 kgs.

A comparative review of the survey results in the years 1394 and 1395 showed that the number of livestock slaughter in the year 1395 experienced a decrease compared with the year 1394. Performance comparison of livestock in the national slaughterhouses in the year 1395 over the year 1394 indicates a 6 percent reduction of quantity of meat production in the authorized livestock slaughterhouses. The quantity of meat production compared with the previous year experienced a decrease of 4 percent for sheep and lambs, 7 percent for goat and kids, 7 percent for cattle and calves, and 7 percent for buffalos and calves and had a 10 percent increase for camel and calves.

A Glance at the Trend of Changes in the Livestock Slaughter Statistics in National Slaughterhouses (the years 1386-1395)

The statistics on the number and weight of edible carcasses of the livestock types slaughtered in the national slaughterhouses during the last ten years show that:

1. The lowest number of edible carcasses of slaughtered sheep and lambs was 4884 thousand with the weight of 90 thousand tons for the year 1389 and the highest number with 10236 thousand carcasses with the weight of 184 thousand tons was related to the year 1394, but this amount reached 9709 thousand carcasses with the weight of 176 thousand tons in the year 1395.
2. The lowest number of edible carcasses of slaughtered goat and kids was 1749 thousand with the weight of 25 thousand tons for the year 1389 and the highest number with 2552 thousand carcasses with the weight of 37 thousand tons was related to the year 1394, but this amount reached 2388 thousand carcasses with the weight of 35 thousand tons in the year 1395.
3. The lowest number of edible carcasses of slaughtered cattle and calves was 1035 thousand with the weight of 198 thousand tons for the year 1392 and the highest number with 1578 thousand carcasses with the weight of 269 thousand tons was related to the year 1387, but this amount reached 1183 thousand carcasses with the weight of 228 thousand tons in the year 1395.
4. The lowest number of edible carcasses of slaughtered buffalo and calves was 20 thousand with the weight of 3 thousand tons for the year 1389 and 1392, and the highest number with 47 thousand carcasses with the weight of 8 thousand tons was related to the year 1387, but this amount reached 24 thousand carcasses with the weight of 5 thousand tons in the year 1395.
5. The lowest number of edible carcasses of slaughtered camel and calves was 19 thousand with the weight of 4 thousand tons for the year 1393 and the highest number with 45 thousand carcasses with the weight of 10 thousand tons was related to the year 1388, but this amount reached 24 thousand carcasses with the weight of 5 thousand tons in the year 1395.

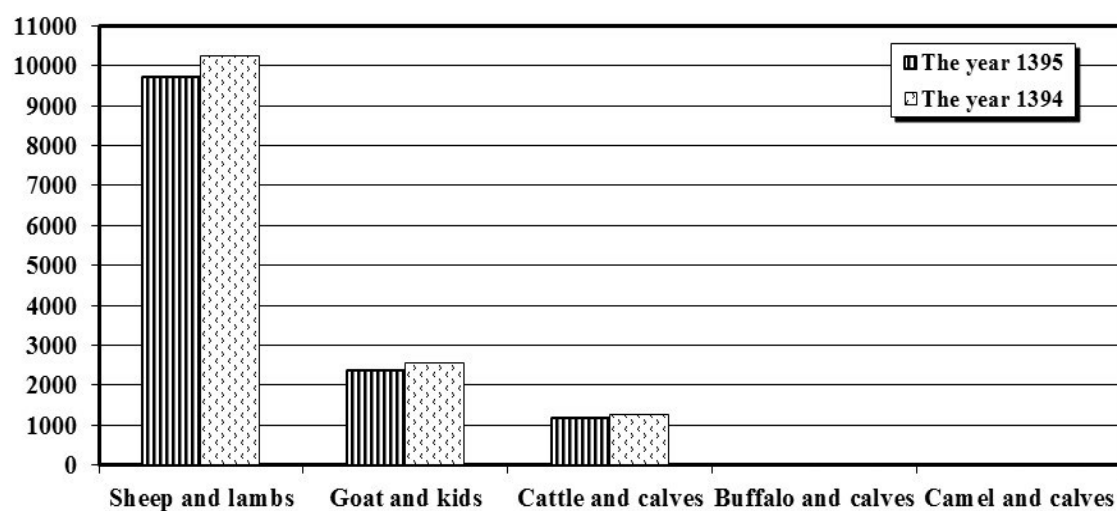

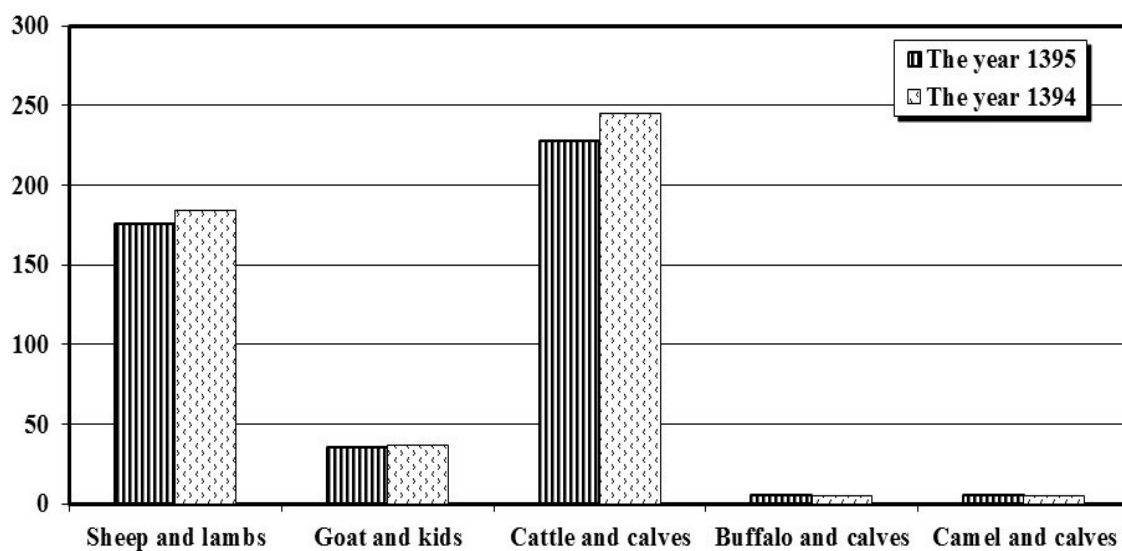

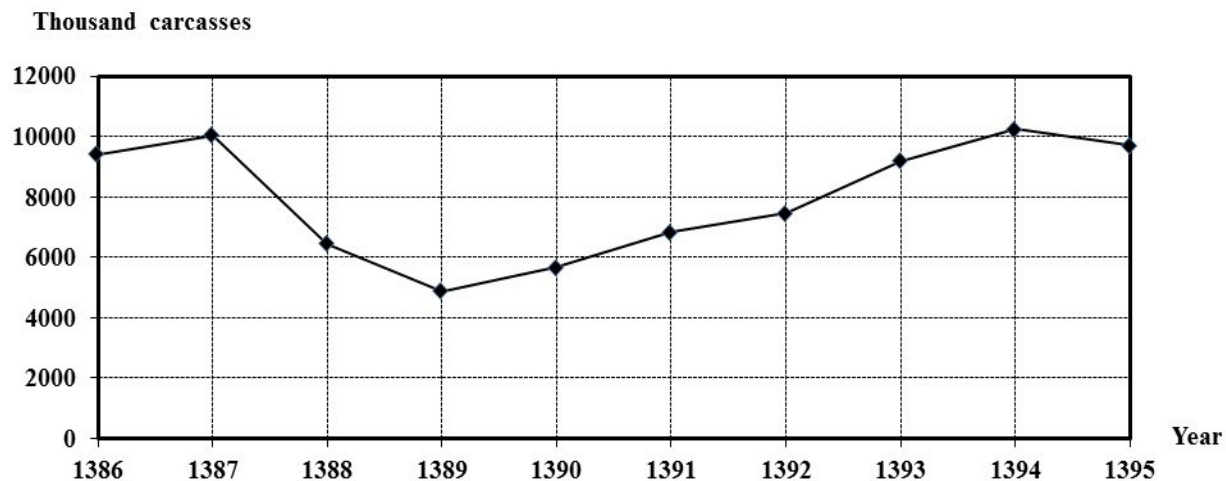

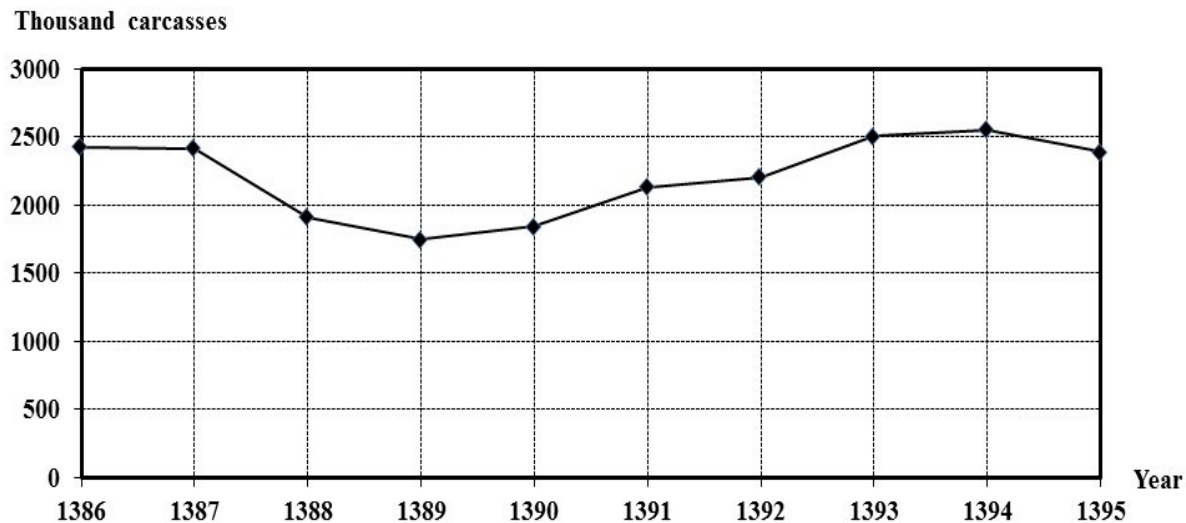

THE NATIONAL SLAUGHTERHOUSES: THE YEARS 1386-1395**

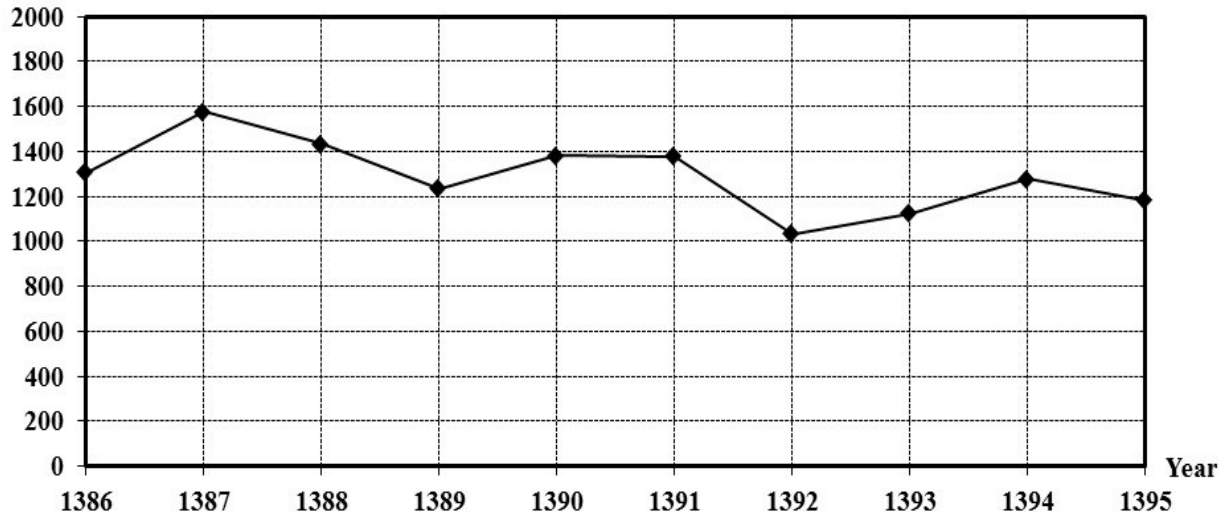


**NUMBER OF EDIBLE CARCASSES OF GOAT AND KIDS SLAUGHTERED IN THE
NATIONAL SLAUGHTERHOUSES: THE YEARS 1386-1395**



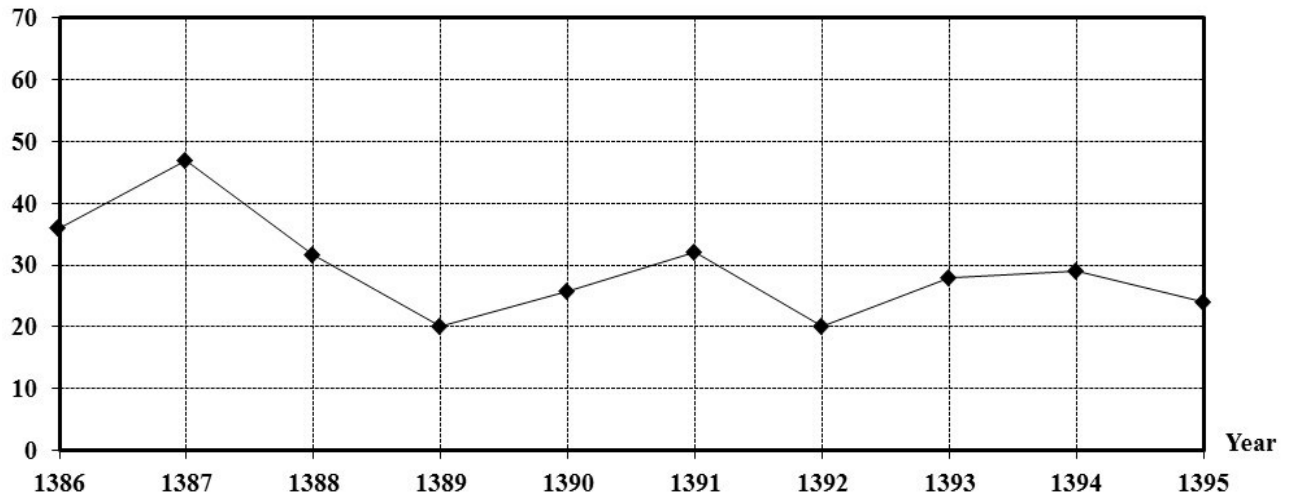
**NUMBER OF EDIBLE CARCASSES OF CATTLE AND CALVES SLAUGHTERED

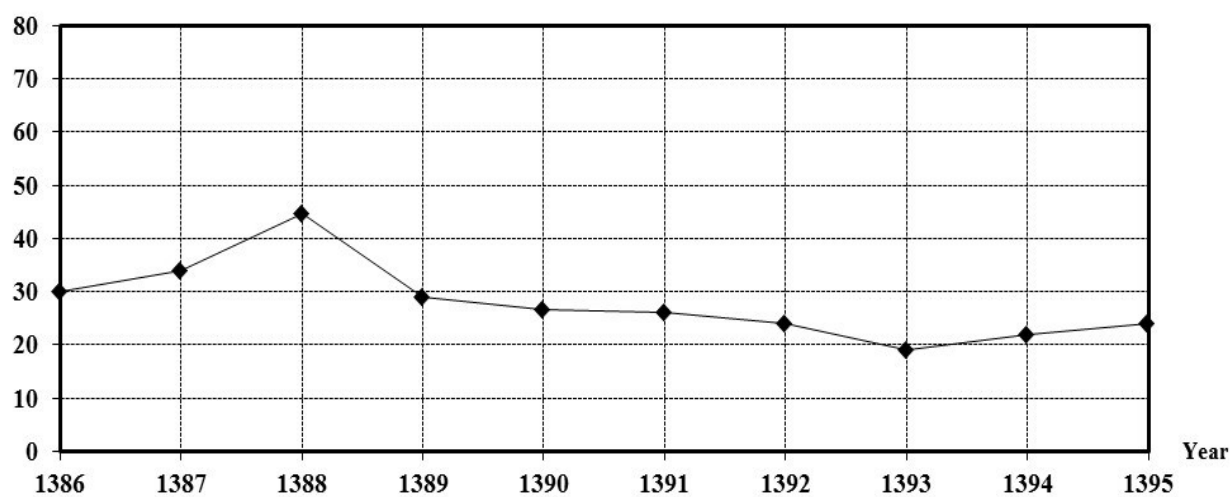
**NUMBER OF EDIBLE CARCASSES OF BUFFALO AND CALVES SLAUGHTERED IN

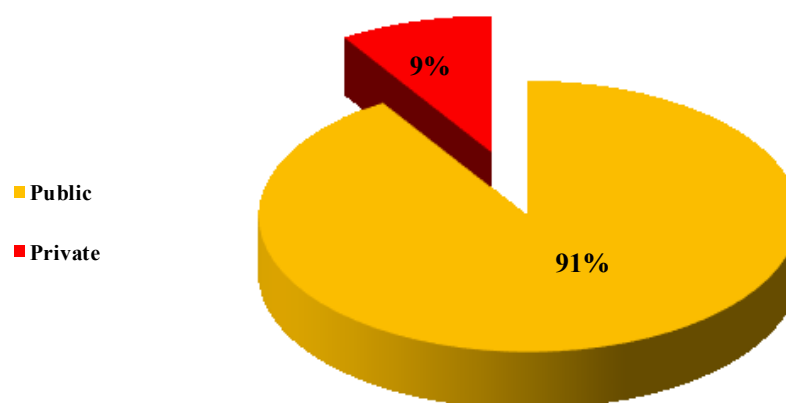
NUMBER OF EDIBLE CARCASSES OF CAMEL AND CALVES SLAUGHTERED IN THE

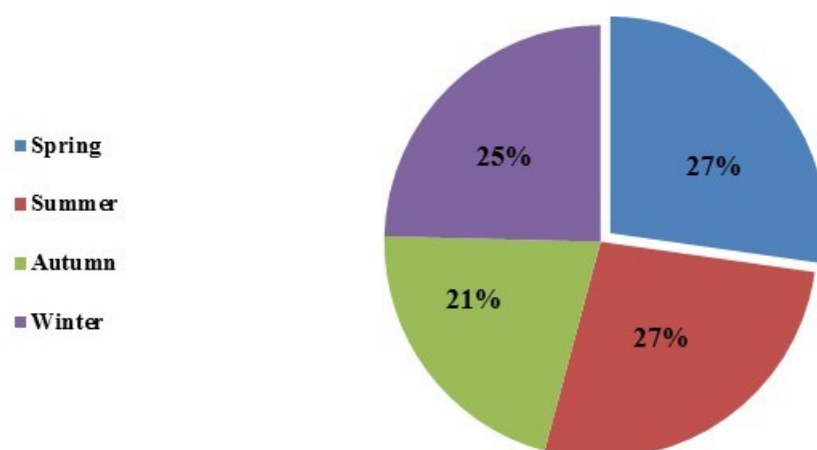

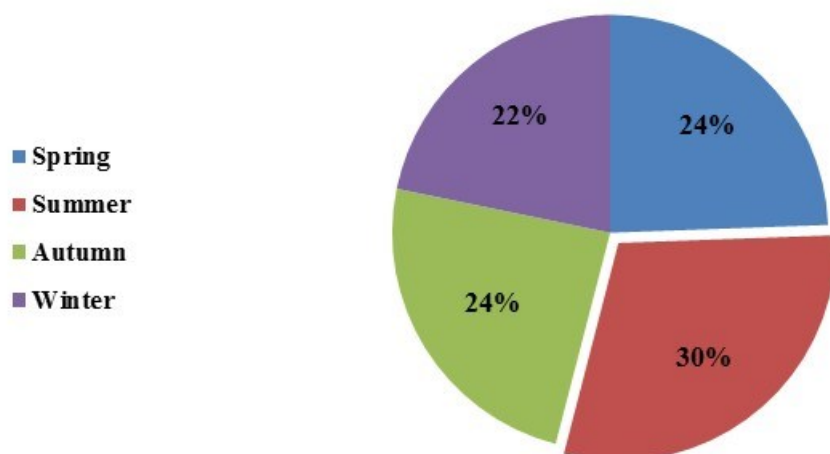

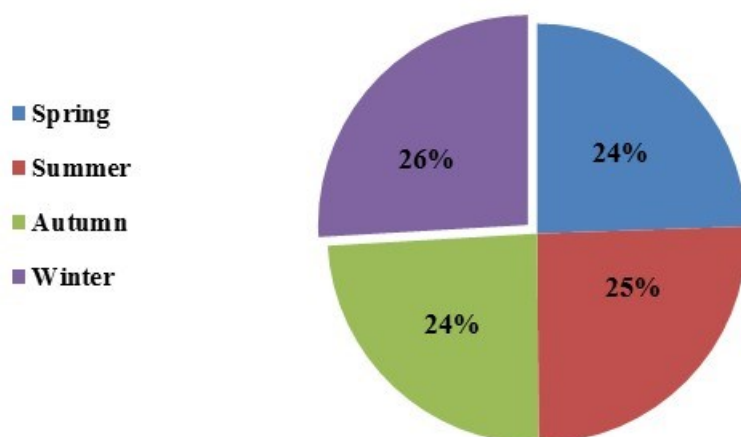
SHEEP AND LAMB SLAUGHTER BY SEASONS, THE YEAR 1395



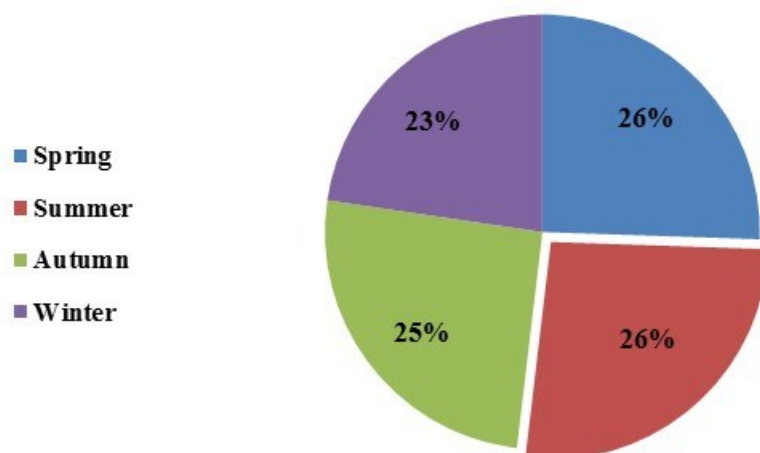
**GOAT AND KIDS SLAUGHTER BY SEASONS,
THE YEAR 1395**



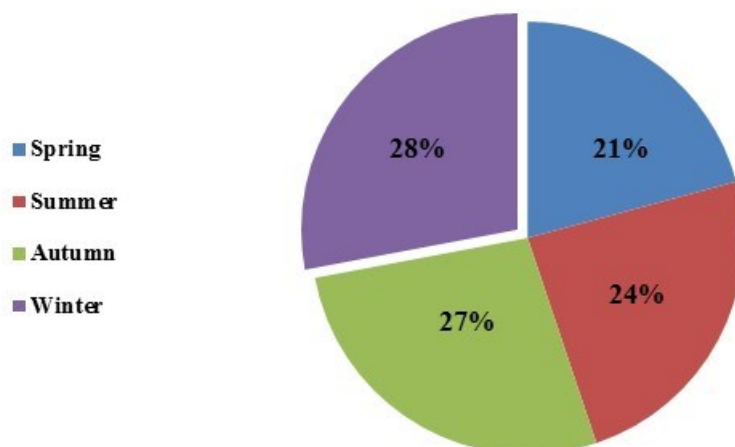
**CATTLE AND CALVES SLAUGHTER BY SEASONS,
